

Leadership students learn about ways to give back to the community



The Leadership Wooster class recently explored the diverse selection of Service Organizations and non-profits in the Wooster area.

Representatives from United Way of Wayne and Holmes Counties, Rotary Club of Wooster, Wooster Noon Lions Club, Kiwanis, and Quota Club of Wayne County kicked off the day by sharing their missions and ways to get involved with their organizations.

The class toured the OneEighty facility and learned how their services are helping people through crisis and trauma, addiction and substance abuse, domestic violence and abuse, and mental health counseling among other services.

The Habitat for Humanity
ReStore gave the class a tour
and explained how the donations
they receive help to fund the
construction of new homes in
the county for people in need of
affordable housing.

Goodwill opened the doors of their industrial facility to the class to see how they are providing jobs for people and also partnering with local companies by taking the labor of routine tasks and helping them reach their production goals.

The class toured the Salvation Army and learned about the Living

Room Project designed to assist the area's homeless population as well as the current need for the warming shelter.

The Wayne County Public Library shared with the class about their current programs and the variety of services and materials they can provide beyond books.

The class participated in round table discussions with representatives from Pregnancy Care Center, Wayne County Children's Advocacy Center, Wooster Boys & Girls Club, Wayne County Humane Society, and Adaptive Sports Ohio.

People to People gave the class a full tour of their facility and explained how they are using the donations they receive to provide people with food, shelter, clothing, and basic health care items.

The class was able to participate in the second session of round table discussions with representatives from Forget-Me-Not Baskets, Christian Children's Home of Ohio, Whit's End, and O'Huddle.

Justin Starlin wrapped up the day with a presentation on effective board membership and how to decide where to dedicate your time and efforts to volunteer service.

For the February 23 Safety Council meeting, Nicole Smith, Diabetes Program Consultant at the Ohio Department of Health, will discuss the impact of prediabetes on your workforce. She will share information about the benefits of the National Diabetes Prevention Program and provide tools, resources, and employer opportunities to determine if this program is right for you and your organization. Given the rising cost of diabetes and the increased risk for COVID-19 complicat

cost of diabetes and the increased risk for COVID-19 complications for people with chronic conditions, this is a presentation you won't want to miss!

After the presentation, attendees will be able to:

- Describe the burden of diabetes and pre-diabetes in Ohio and on your workforce.
- ② Describe the National Diabetes Prevention Program, including participant eligibility, program goals, and program delivery modes.
- 3 Identify next steps to determine if the National Diabetes Prevention Program is a good fit for their organization.

Nicole Smith provides technical assistance to the CDC-recognized National Diabetes Prevention Programs in Ohio. She also works with employers and health plans (both commercial and Medicaid) to expand coverage for the National DPP as a medical or wellness benefit. She holds a Bachelor's in Health and Sports Studies from Miami University, and a Master of Public Health in Physical Activity and Public Health from the University of South Carolina. She is also a Certified Health Education Specialist and has served in several board member roles, including her current role as Professional Development Chair, for the Ohio Society for Public Health Education.




