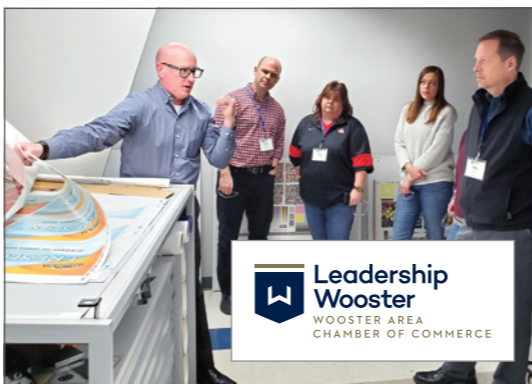

Safety Council

January Safety Council recap: Safe winter driving

Wooster Area Safety Council met in January to learn about Safe Winter Driving and the Dangers of Distracted Driving.

Manuel Vazquez Ederra, of Federated Insurance, spoke to the group about ways to remain safe when winter weather makes the roadways hazardous. Make sure your vehicle's battery is fully charged and the tires have adequate tread for winter driving. Also, stock your car with the proper supplies for winter-related situations. A snow shovel, warm clothing and First-Aid supplies are good items to keep in your car in case of an emergency.

However, he did recommend to avoid driving during adverse conditions if at all possible. Manuel offered some tips if driving is absolutely necessary: adjust your speed,



clear your windshield of snow and ice, increase your following distance and start and stop smoothly.

The three main types of distracted driving are visual, manual and cognitive. Texting while driving is the most dangerous distraction because it involves all three types. A driver can travel the length of a football field in the 4.6 seconds it takes to glance at a phone to send or receive a message. Manuel suggested limiting calls to emergencies and using a hands-free phone whenever possible.

He also stressed the importance for companies to have a policy in place related to distracted and unsafe driving in order to protect themselves in the event a crash occurs. This also makes the importance of safe driving clear to employees. Manuel pointed out that safe travel should always be a priority.



Upcoming Safety Council to feature mock Industrial Commission hearing

At the March 25 Safety Council meeting, the attorneys of Morrow & Meyer, LLC will be demonstrating a mock Industrial Commission hearing.

They will present a short hearing on the issue of allowance of a workers' compensation claim, complete with a claimant, employer, representatives and a hearing officer. They will also be available to answer questions regarding workers' compensation claims.
