Upcoming Wooster Safety Council meeting to address Fall Hazards in the Workplace in May

Slips, trips and falls account for over \$11 billion a year in workplace injuries.
Employers also have to account for the days missed by employees as a result of treating the injury, costing millions in lost productivity and higher insurance costs.
Most of these incidents can be prevented by understanding what causes

them in the first place and training employees on proper set-up and safe use of equipment on the job site.

On Wednesday, May 17, Eric White, Construction Safety Consultant for the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Division of Safety & Hygiene will present to the Wooster Area Safety Council about Fall Hazards in the Workplace.

Attendees of the meeting will learn:

- How to comply with OSHA's Fall Protection Standards
- Determine the appropriate fall protection system and method to use for a given hazard
- A B C's of Fall Arrest

Eric is a Construction Safety Consultant for the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation, Division of Safety & Hygiene. He has been with the Division for 23 years and in the safety field for 28 years. Prior to coming to work for the Division of Safety & Hygiene, Eric held positions with the Mechanical Contractors Association, Honda of America, OHM Corporation and worked many years as a carpenter. He holds a BS in Environmental Hazardous Materials Management/Industrial Hygiene from the University of Findlay.





Leadership Wooster class explores local County and City Government

In April, the Leadership Wooster class explored City and County Government! Chief Fisher kicked off the day with an overview of the Wooster Police Department. The class then learned about the proactive initiatives taken by local agencies to keep drugs off of the streets from Sergeant Shonk of the Wooster PD and Interim Director Joshua Hunt of Medway.

Everyone was happy to see a demonstration from two K-9s alongside a tour of the Safety Center. The class also got to witness the Fire Arms Training Simulator and see how they respond in intense situations that police officers often encounter. After that, Chief Saley of the Wooster Fire Department gave leadership advice and an overview of the City's fire department stations and activities. Mayor Bob Breneman then gave a recap of his term as mayor and shared some projects that are in the works for the city.

In the afternoon, the class traveled to the * Wayne County Municipal Court, where they heard from Wayne County Commissioner Sue Smail. Captain Doug Hunter of the Wayne County Sherriff's Office talked about the different divisions in their organization. Then Wayne County Prosecutor Angela Wypasek gave an overview of her office and explained their role in the court system.





To end the day, Judges Michael Rickett and Timothy VanSickle gave an overview of the Wayne County Municipal Court and Court of Common Pleas. It was another packed day with a lot of good information and leadership insights shared from leaders across the City of Wooster and Wayne County.
