




Attend the First Safety Council Meeting to Learn About Healthy Aging

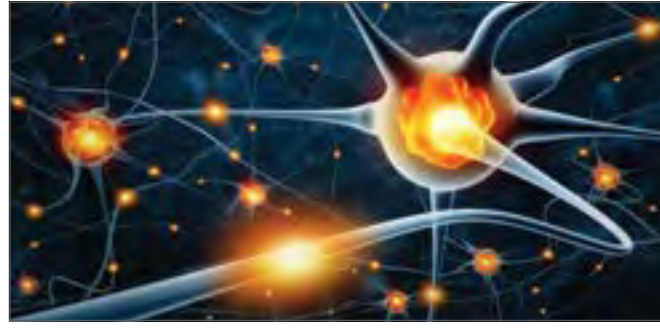
