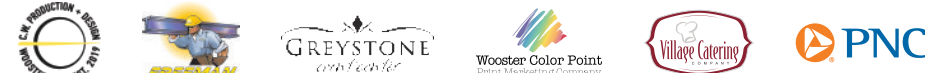

# Leadership Wooster covers Community Service, Volunteerism, and Human Services



The Leadership Wooster class began their February session at The Village Network where they learned about how their organization is having a positive impact and empowering youth and their families. Later in the day, the class was able to tour the campus and see first-hand how The Village Network is meeting its mission.

The class heard from Katie Kogelman about United Way of Wayne and Holmes Counties and what they are doing to help people improve their lives.

The class experienced a session of Service Club Speed dating where they spent time at different stations hearing from the Rotary Club of Wooster, Wooster Noon Lions Club, Kiwanis Club of Wooster, and Quota Club of Wayne County.

The next hour was spent having round table discussions with representatives from Pregnancy Care Center, Wayne County

Children's Advocacy Center, Wooster Boys & Girls Club, Wayne County Humane Society, NAMI of Wayne & Holmes Counties, and the Wayne County Community Foundation.

The Habitat for Humanity ReStore was the next stop of the day. Executive Director Beth Weaver gave the class a tour of the store and explained how the ReStore supports Habitat for Humanity's vision of a world where everyone has a decent place to live.

A tour and overview of OneEighty was the next stop of the day. John Fishburn, Clinical Director, shared about what their organization is doing to help people change direction.

The class enjoyed a meal prepared by the Salvation Army's kitchen. Majors Thomas and Victoria Clark gave an overview of how they are supporting people in the Wooster community and gave the group a tour of their facility.

Joe Szeker, Executive Director, gave the class an overview and a tour of People to People.

From there, the class traveled to Goodwill for a tour of their Industrial Services Division where they help local companies by taking on routine tasks and helping them to reach their production goals.

Then the class returned to The Village Network for another Round Table session where they heard from Forget-Me-Not Baskets, Romich Foundation, O'Huddle, Wayne County Community Action, Wayne County Children's STEAM Playlab, and Friendtique/The Nest.

Samira Zimmerly, President of the Wooster Area Chamber of Commerce wrapped up the day with a discussion on Effective Board Membership.

Throughout the course of the day, the class heard from over 25 organizations.
