September Leadership Wooster session focuses on Community Development

For the September session of Leadership Wooster, the class spent the day at Western Reserve Group learning about community development in Wooster.

To start the day, Lauren Mingay, a Realtor with Re/Max Showcase, shared the latest statistics about the housing market in the area and what she is anticipating for the future. Maribeth

Burns, President of the Wayne Economic Development Council, gave an overview of the new and upcoming projects for the county and how the WEDC contributes to the development of the area. The students learned the history of how the North End was developed from Jerry Baker, owner of J. Baker Industries. For the traveling tour, everyone boarded a bus where Justin Starlin, CEO, Compak, taught the class

about the history and different factors that impact development in Wooster. Matt Long and Chad Boreman described the various projects they have been involved in as local investors in the community. Leadership students had an opportunity to learn about the Chamber from President Samira Zimmerly. Shannon Waller, Executive Director, Main Street Wooster, told the class about the impact Main Street Wooster has had



on the downtown. The day wrapped up with a discussion led by Rodd Welker of Eagle Advisor Group on empowering leadership.


