Kinderplatz is open Saturday September 28 from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. with bounce-houses, a craft area and games for the kids to enjoy.


Art & Craft vendors will be set up with their homemade creations available for sale. Vendor's items range from wood carvings to jewelry and everything in between.
