PROGRAMS & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The Chamber offers a variety of professional development opportunities to help members grow as business professionals and create connections within the community.

Leadership Wooster

Since 1996, the Leadership Wooster program has made an effort to train leaders who would go on to build a stronger community. By providing educational and networking opportunities, Leadership Wooster brings the "best and brightest" together to address local issues and needs.

Educational Series

Hosted by business members, these seminars focus on issues, special interests, and education related to successfully operating and growing a business. Refreshments are typically provided.

Safety Council

The Chamber and Bureau of Workers' Compensation Division of Safety & Hygiene co-sponsor this monthly program to provide information on health and safety in the workplace. Eligible participants may earn up to 3% off of their premiums.

Wayne Economic Forum

Founded in 2013 by a group of Chamber leaders, the Economic Forum brings top-notch, internationally-known speakers in the business community to Wooster to present business philosophies, experiences and leadership styles.

Health Care Day

Wayne County Health Care Day opens the doors of seven health care providers throughout Wayne County to local students that have a general interest in the health care field. On average, 300 students from 11 school districts participate in this career awareness program.

Manufacturing Day

Wayne County Manufacturing Day is the largest event of its kind in the state of Ohio. Connecting over 600 high school students from 11 school districts and 18 local manufacturers to inspire the next generation of workers.

- Wayne County Lemonade Day

The Lemonade Day, Wayne County program offers children the opportunity to set, develop, and implement achievable business practices to execute their dream of running a successful business – a lemonade stand. The program encourages financial literacy by inviting participants to determine costs, set a budget, earn a profit, and even give back to the community by donating a portion of their proceeds to a charity of their choice.

COMMUNITY EVENTS

Wayne County Home & Garden Show

Held annually at the Wayne County Fairgrounds, the Home & Garden Show is a one-stop shop for all of your home and gardening needs. Free and open to the public, this event gathers 15,000 – 20,000 community members yearly. Chamber members receive a discount on exhibit space.

Woosterfest

This Oktoberfest-style event is one of the community's longest-running traditions. Free and open to the public, this event gathers 15,000-20,000 community members annually. Thousands travel to historic Downtown Wooster to enjoy live music, great food, contests, children's activities and so much more!

The Let It Glow Chamber Holiday Light Competition encourages community members every year to deck their homes with lights, lawn ornaments, wreaths, and more to help bring holiday cheer to families in Wooster.
